

Junior Bible Quiz

JBQ Facts

- Helps 3rd to 6th grade students learn Bible facts, scriptures and doctrine.
- A quiz team consists of a head coach and from two to eight youth eligible to quiz. Only four quizzers are allowed to quiz at the same time, so a roster of four to six is ideal.
- Eligibility is restricted to Christian youth who are enrolled in grades 3-6 as of September, which begins the official year of competition.
- The coach will be permitted to have a maximum of two assistants during the match.
- Teams may be formed by AG or non-AG churches, Christian schools, home school groups or two or more churches combining students because they are not able to sponsor their own team.
- An organization may sponsor more than one team.

Place/Time for the JBQ Meets

Teams are grouped into leagues which meet on the first Saturday of the month in October, November, December, February and March. The season includes a tournament in January and district finals after the last meet in March.

Is it similar to Teen Bible Quiz?

There are several important differences.

- The material does not change from year to year.
- It centers around the Bible Fact-Pak, a carefully selected set of 576 questions covering the entire Bible.
- Every attempt was made to write both questions and answers in the vocabulary of the junior.
- Students study from the Bible Fact-Pak cards or Bible Fact-Pak Study Guide. All quizzing is based on these questions.
- Refer to JBQ schedule for current question rotation.

Doesn't allowing the students to study the actual quiz questions promote "rote" learning?

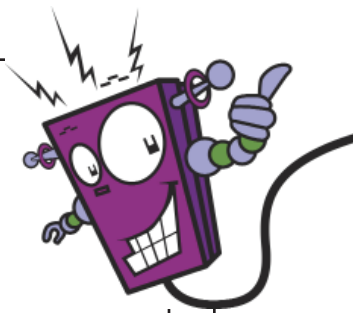
Definitely! That is the strength of the program. The junior is at the peak of his ability to memorize. The parent or teacher may give assistance in helping him gain understanding when he needs it. However, many of the questions are written in a way that helps with comprehension and application. For instance, instead of asking the child to recite the seventh commandment the question is, "Which of the Ten Commandments protects the sacredness of marriage?"

Pee Wee Bible Quiz

Pee Wee Bible Quiz Facts

- Helps children from Kindergarten through 3rd Grade learn Bible facts, scripture and doctrine. *Grade Exceptions: Third graders who have completed two years of Pee Wee Quiz may participate in Junior Bible Quiz.
- Other exceptions for 3rd grade participants in PBQ will be given individual consideration by the Pee Wee and JBQ coordinators.
- Teaches children to participate in a simple, competitive way.
- Prepares children for participating in JBQ.
- Gives children an opportunity to meet other children from nearby churches.

Place/Time for the Pee Wee Quiz Meet

The first Saturday of the month in October, November and December, usually at the same church as the Junior Bible Quiz teams.

Material Studied

Approximately 150 questions per year from the Bible Fact-Pak or Bible Fact-Pak Study Guide. Refer to the JBQ/PBQ schedule for the current sequence of questions to be studied.

Advantages of Pee Wee Bible Quiz

- The material is simple enough for children to learn.
- The three-month season is short enough for young attention spans.
- The more intense competition of older levels of quizzing is not present.
- League trophies are given to the top teams and all quizzers get recognized at the end of the season.
- Ribbons are given to all quizzers with a 90% or better accuracy record. Individual quizzers may receive awards even if his/her team does not win a trophy.
- Buzzer sets for quickness of response are used only during overtime periods.
- If children are in the Pee Wee Bible Quiz program for two years, they can enter the Junior Bible Quiz program knowing all of the 10-point questions.
- The questions studied in Pee Wee Bible Quiz one year are the same ones that the Junior Bible Quiz program studies the following year. This helps them have a more successful start in Junior Bible Quiz.
